- The National e-Health Policy and Strategy has been launched.

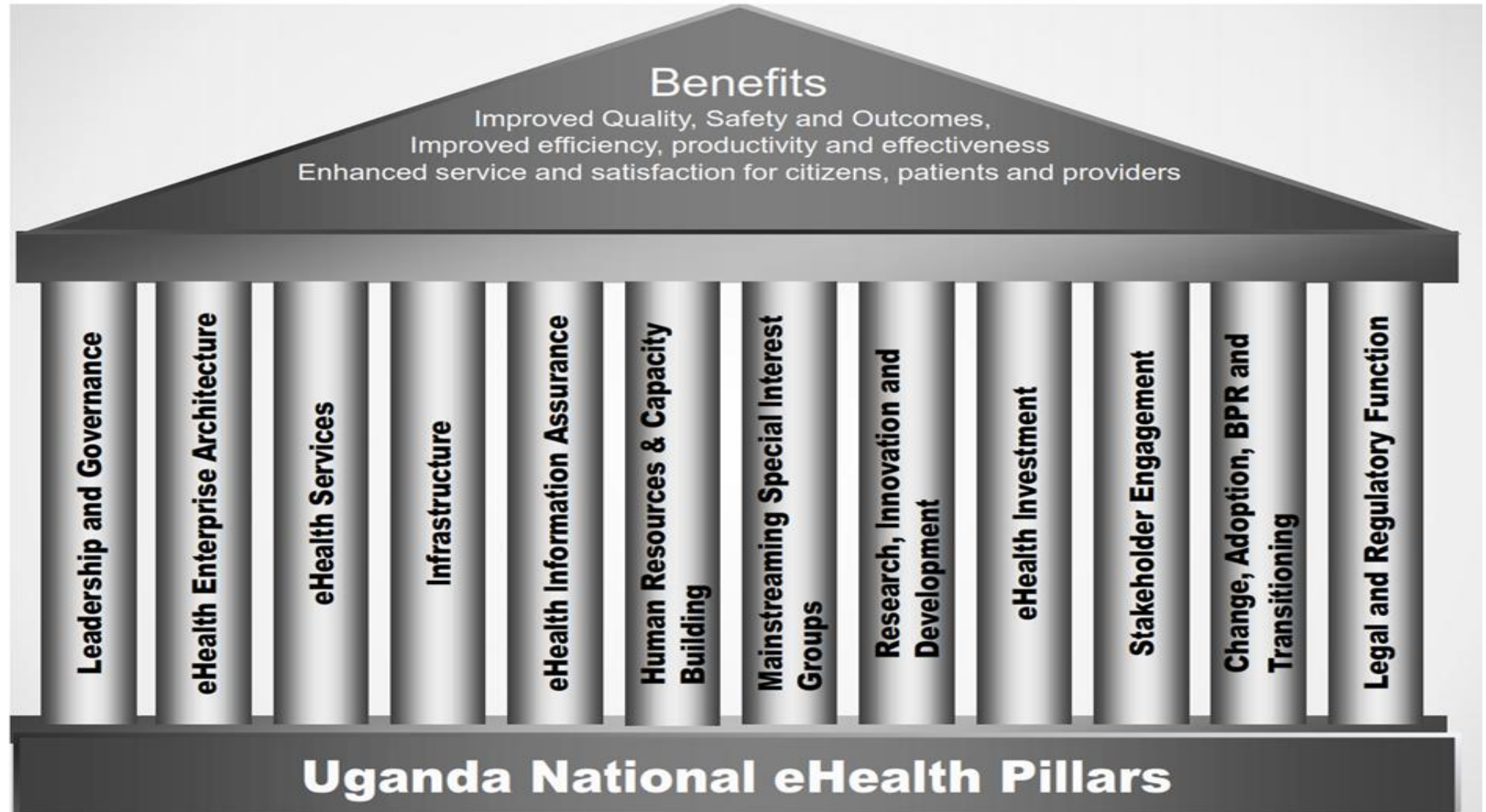


Launch of the eHealth Policy and Strategy in May 2018



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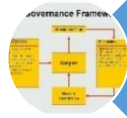

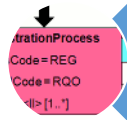

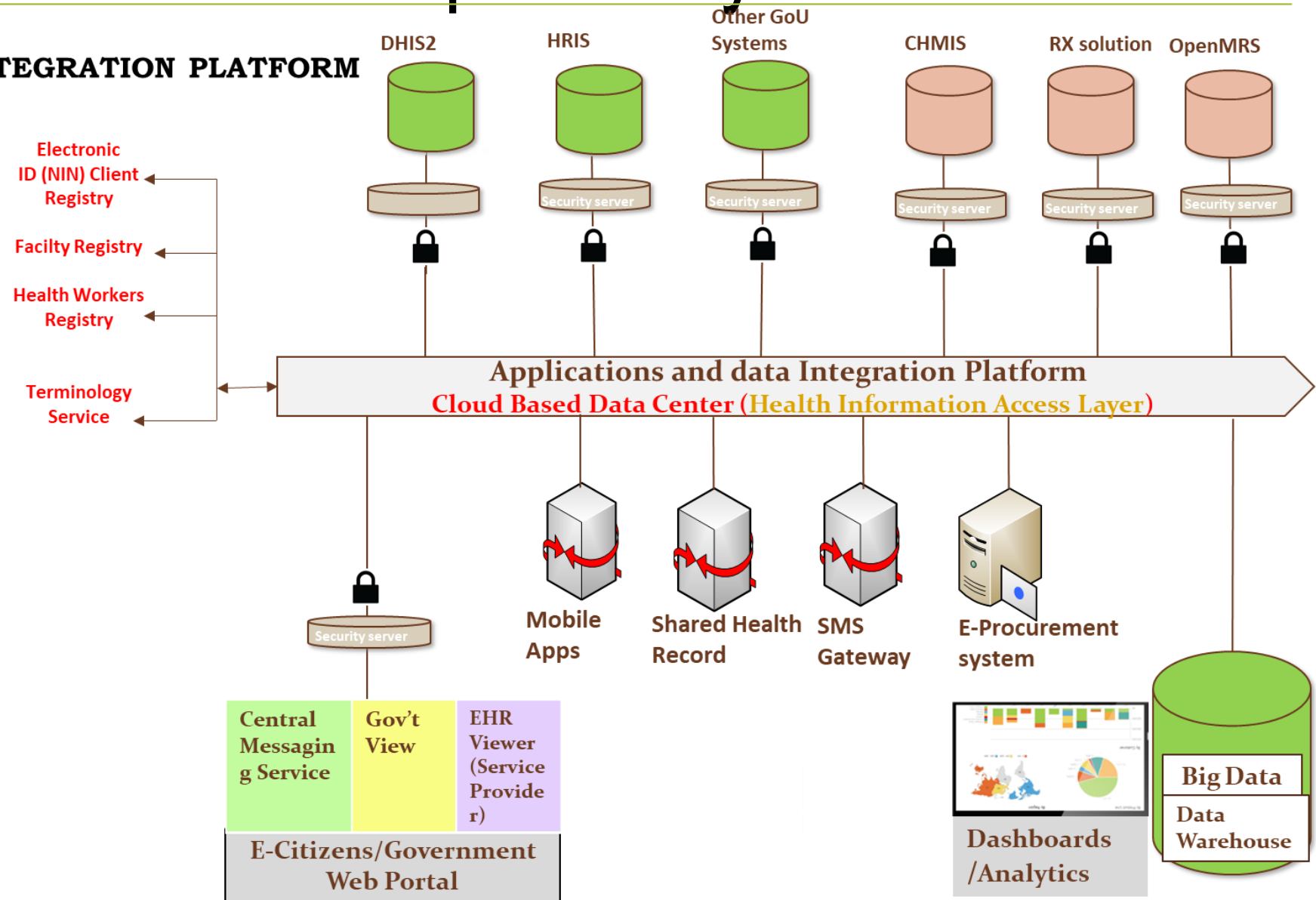




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# eHealth Interoperability Framework

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# On-going Activities

- Evaluation of digital health interventions (an accreditation subcommittee was set up, over 40 registered so far)
- Populating the Digital Health Atlas with interventions in the country
- Development of Master Facility Registry (list approved)
- Development of Health Worker Registry
- Development of Client Registry





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# On-going activities

- Formulation of data security guidelines (recommendation from interoperability maturity assessment)
- Formulation of the HIS Strategy (key output of the HIS SOCI assessment)
- Revised the RHIS (HMIS) –integrated all programs and refugee data into one system.
- Strengthening existing systems (DHIS, iHRIS, RapidPRO, OpenMRS)





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# Planned Activities

- Development of eHealth Roadmap Document
- Development of national information exchange standards
- Development of the interoperability layer
- Development of terminology standards



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# Success Factors

- Use of global goods (such as Maturity models by HDC, Digital Health Atlas, DHIS, OpenHIE, GDHI, among others).
- Support of the Ministry of Health Senior Leadership.
- Collaboration with various Partners and Donors.

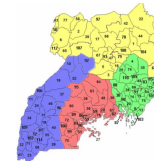

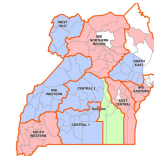

- Duplication of efforts across health sector amidst scanty and un-optimally utilized resources
- Lack of standardization & low adoption of open standards
- Lack of a transparent process for review and accreditation process for e-health innovations prior to pilot or scale-up
  - Lack of interoperable e-health initiatives
  - Lack of appropriate control of e-health initiatives
- Scanty or very low use of data on health service delivery
  - Relaxed mode of enforcing national & international laws/regulations on health information management
- Security of health data? Privacy? Scalability? Several innovations stagnant at pilot stage? Proprietary e-health solutions that are not sustainable? Data governance?

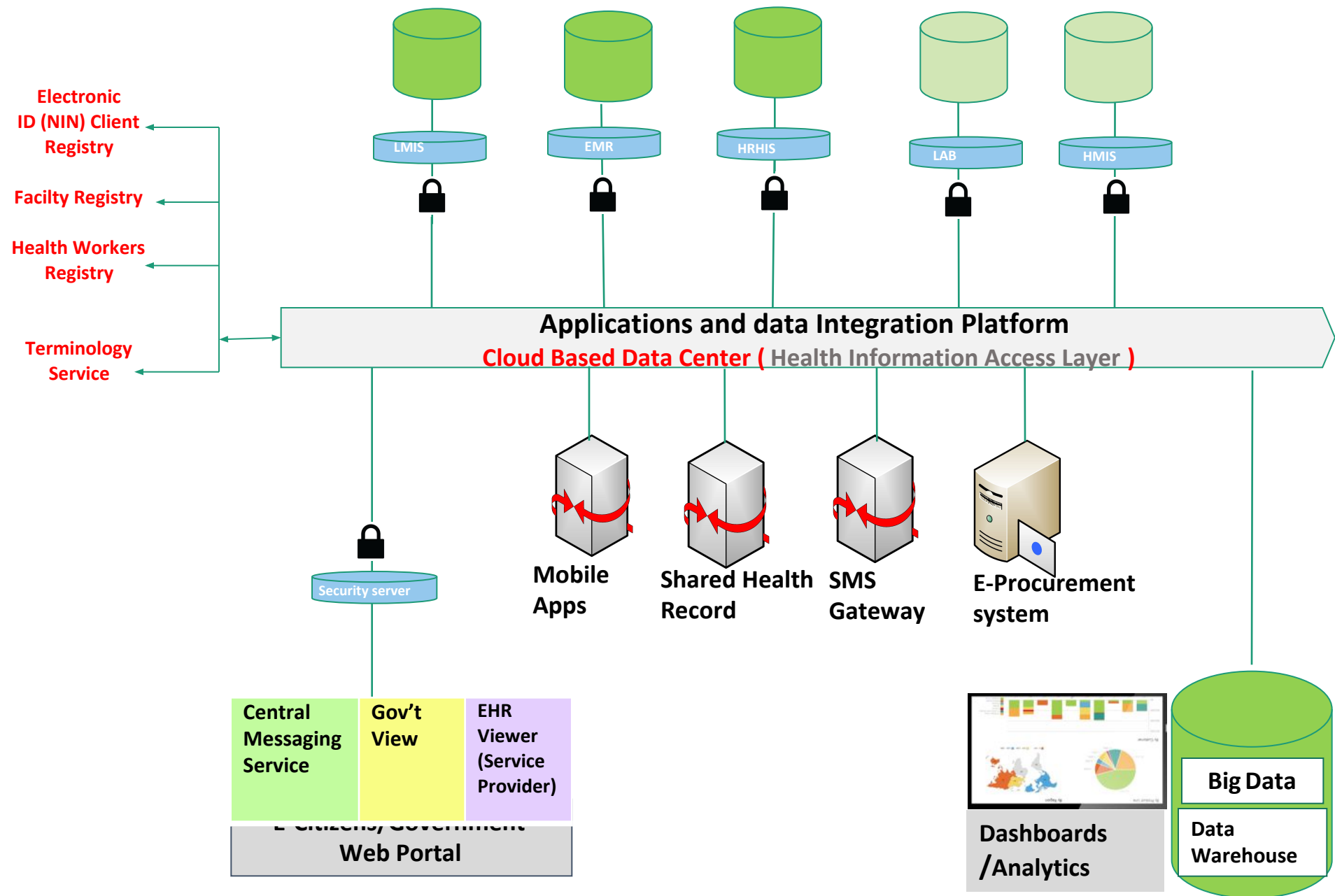
